1 Which Magic Star Trek product should you buy?

Buy for the night you want. The Beginner Box teaches two players, Commander decks seat one player, and Draft Night runs a four-player event.

2 Beginner Box or Commander deck: two very different first nights

Choose the Beginner Box for a guided first duel. Choose one Commander deck when your group already plays Commander and needs a complete seat.

3 How to choose among the four Commander decks

Pick a Commander by play style, not by the captain on the front. Read the full deck list and mechanics before committing to a preorder.

4 Draft Night versus Play Boosters

Draft Night is the tidy four-player event kit. A Play Booster display suits repeated drafts, more players, or anyone who wants packs without the event bundle.

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Bundle, Beam Me Up Bundle and Scene Boxes

The regular Bundle is a broad sampler. Scene Boxes are display-minded mini collections, while Beam Me Up is a larger premium assortment.

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Are Star Trek Collector Boosters worth it?

Collector Boosters sell treatments and scarcity, not a better way to learn. Buy them for collecting only after the playable route is settled.
