Two-copy test

1. Play one copy stock

Do not double the carton before identifying the deck’s actual bottleneck.
2. Count starter-exclusive needs

Subtract the copies already in one deck.
3. Compare complete routes

Buy a second deck only when it beats the needed singles and leaves useful extras.

First event bag

- ☐ Legal 50-card deck plus Leader — Verify current block policy.
- ☐ Ten DON cards in opaque sleeves — Keep them visually distinct.
- ☐ Deck box, counters, rules access, water — Pack the boring things that keep a round calm.
