Rehearse one recognizable deck	Blue-Eyes White Destiny	Official database and NEURON list check

Genesys point check

1. Open the current point list

Do not rely on a saved screenshot or old list.
2. Count Main, Extra, and Side together

Use the event's announced point cap.
3. Confirm the event cap

The organizer's listing controls the table.
4. Recheck in NEURON

Save the exact list before registering.

First three paper games

- ☐ Game 1 — Rehearse the opening line with physical cards.
- ☐ Game 2 — Name the interruption window before resolving it.
- ☐ Game 3 — Record one repeated failure and change only what the log explains.

Small useful kit

- ☐ One complete legal list — Choose Genesys or Advanced before buying upgrades.
- ☐ Small-card opaque sleeves — Carry matching spares and an official fitted deck box.
- ☐ Current references — Keep the event page, list, and NEURON entry reachable.
